OVERVIEW

This multi-professional one-day course covers simulation training especially centred on debriefing skills, principles of small group teaching and the role of human factors and their role in medical error. The day comprises course design, including the identifying of learning outcomes, and delivery. Candidates then follow up with a day of supervised teaching prior to accreditation by the London Deanery.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, participants will have learned:

- The principles of Crisis Resource Management (CRM) and how to teach them
- How to debrief teams and individuals
- How to deal with different group dynamics and maximise the effectiveness of teaching
- How to identify learning outcomes and scenario design

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is aimed at senior doctors and nurses within the London Deanery catchment area who have an interest in medical simulation, acute care courses or healthcare education. Support is required from your Educational Supervisor.
