An intensive 'hands-on' full immersion course in high-fidelity medical simulation.

You will receive:

1. *Comprehensive web-based introductory material*
2. *Two day course involving you directly in 12 simulations.*
3. *3 videoed feedback sessions where your performance in giving feedback will be 'debriefed'*
4. *Post-course support and mentoring*

This is a multi-professional 2 day course for clinical teachers interested in simulation as a teaching tool. The emphasis is on giving effective feedback in the context of a working simulator environment. You do not need to have experience in simulation but you do need to want to put your practical clinical experience and enthusiasm into teaching. We work on the assumption that simulators are tools for clinical teachers rather than a teaching method in themselves. However, we also realise that clinical teachers need help and support, particularly in understanding how we teach and how our students learn. This course will help you to become familiar with the simulator environment as well as to critically examine your skills as a clinical teacher.

You will learn in small groups (maximum 4) each facilitated by an expert in medical simulation. As well, there will be a concurrent series of short workshops on teaching technique, simulator technology, course content and problem-solving.
