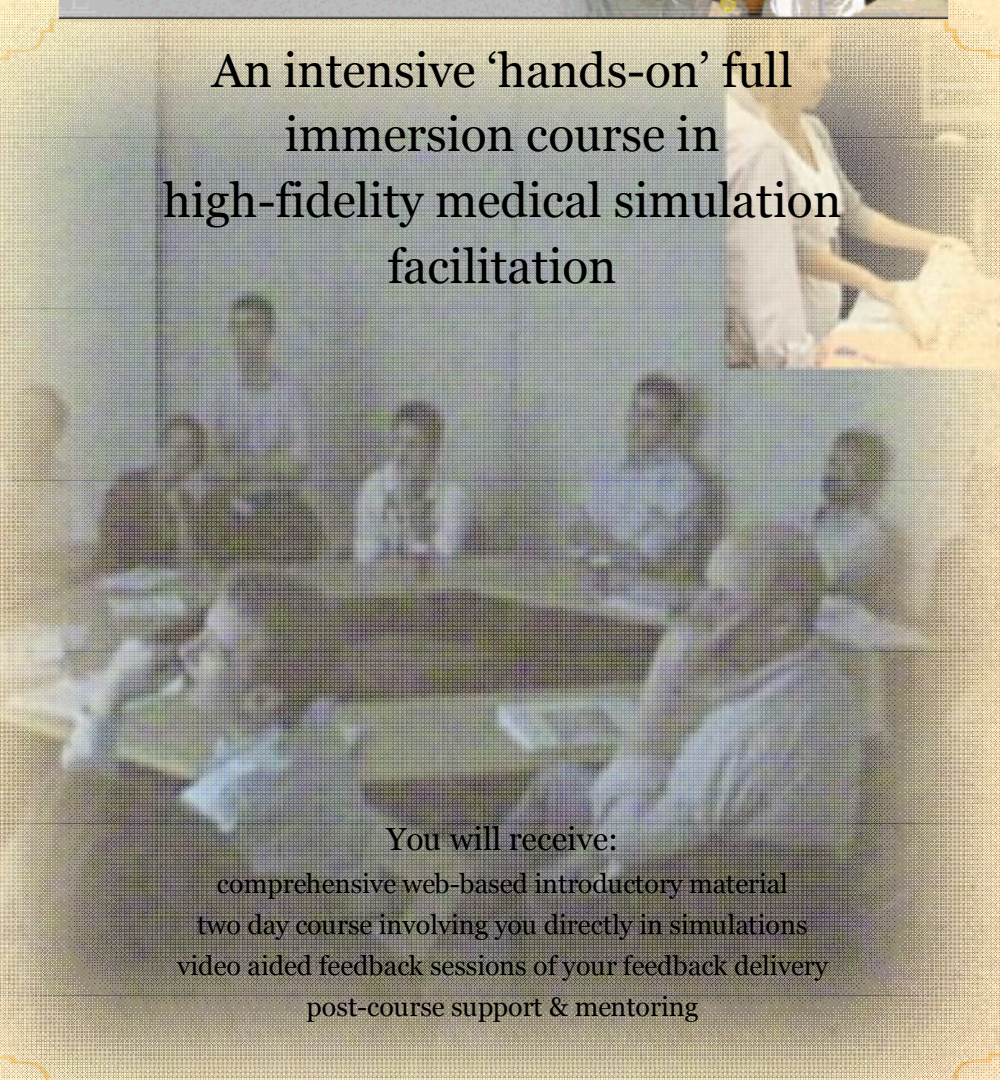

An intensive 'hands-on' full immersion course in high-fidelity medical simulation facilitation

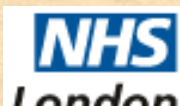


You will receive:

This is a multi-professional 2 day course for clinical teachers interested in simulation as a teaching tool. The emphasis is on giving feedback in the context of a working simulator environment. You do not need to have experience in simulation but do need to want to put your practical clinical experience and enthusiasm into teaching using high fidelity simulation. We work on the assumption that simulators are tools for clinical teachers rather than a teaching method in themselves. However, we also realise that clinical teachers need help and support, particularly in understanding how we teach and how our students learn. In this context this course will help you to become familiar with the simulator environment as well as to critically examine your skills as a clinical teacher.
